
2. Name of the Programme: Investor Awareness Program on Commodity Derivative Market



Kula Women's College, Nambol in collaboration with North Kamrup College, Baghmara, Barpeta, Assam; Naorem Birahari College, Khundrakpam, Manipur; Ecological Useful Productive and Social Development Organisation, Thoubal, Manipur and Social Welfare and Development Centre, Imphal-W, Manipur. 


