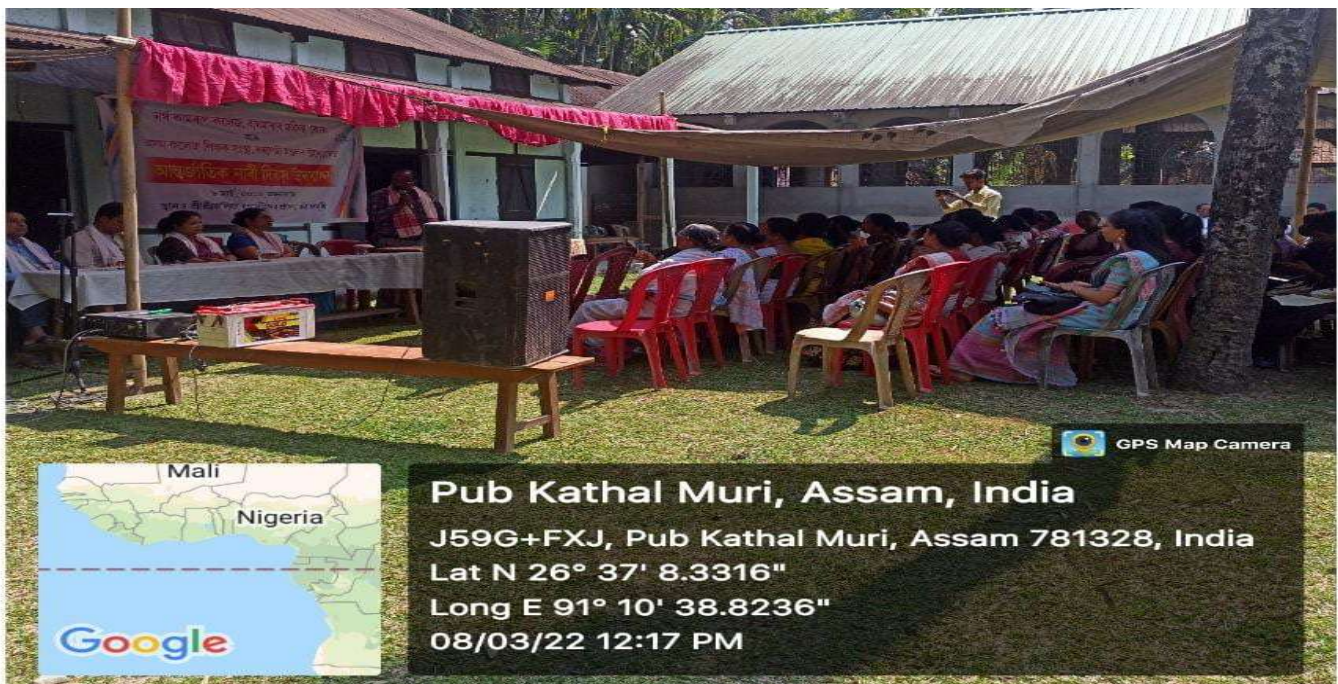


International women's day

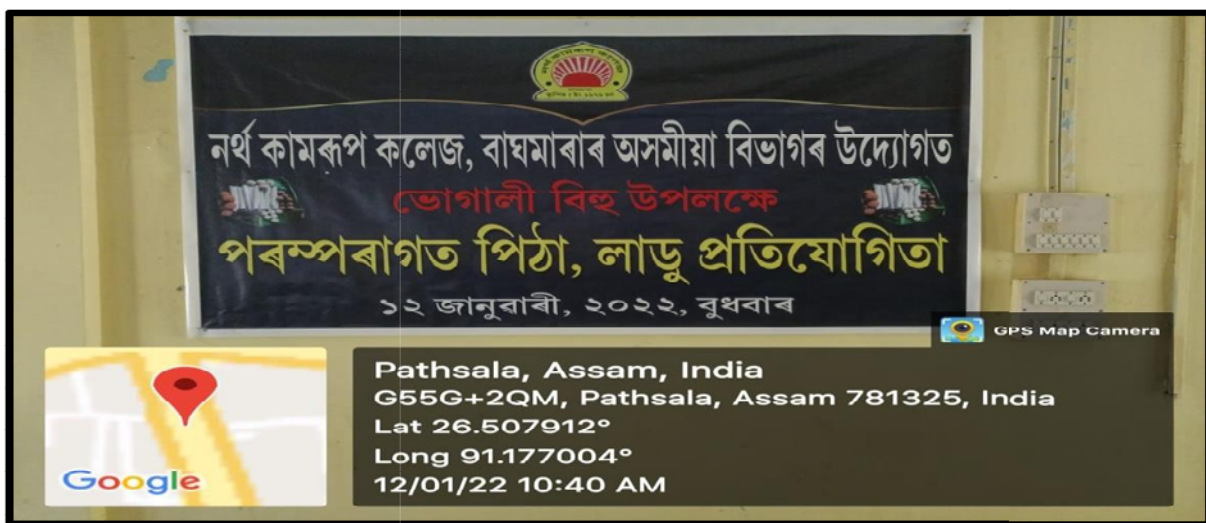


Laru-pitha competition

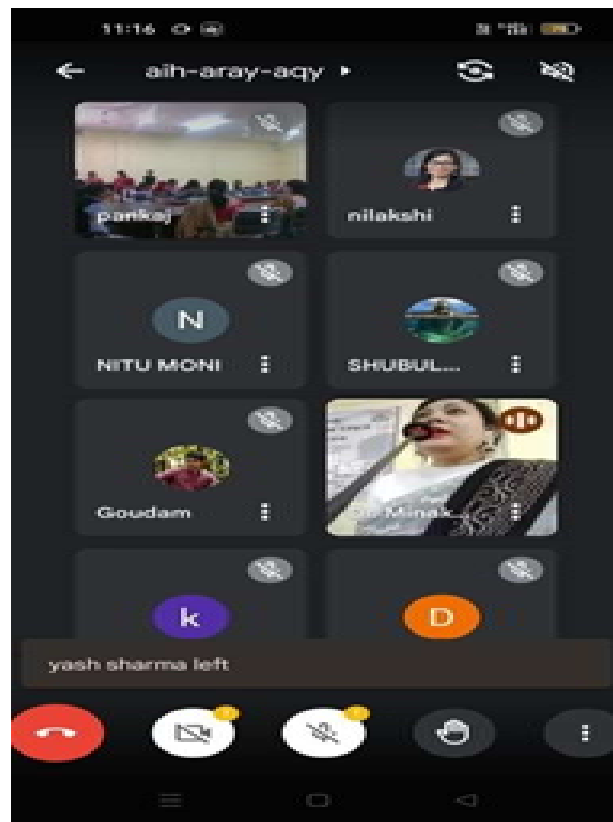


National Level Hybrid Seminar

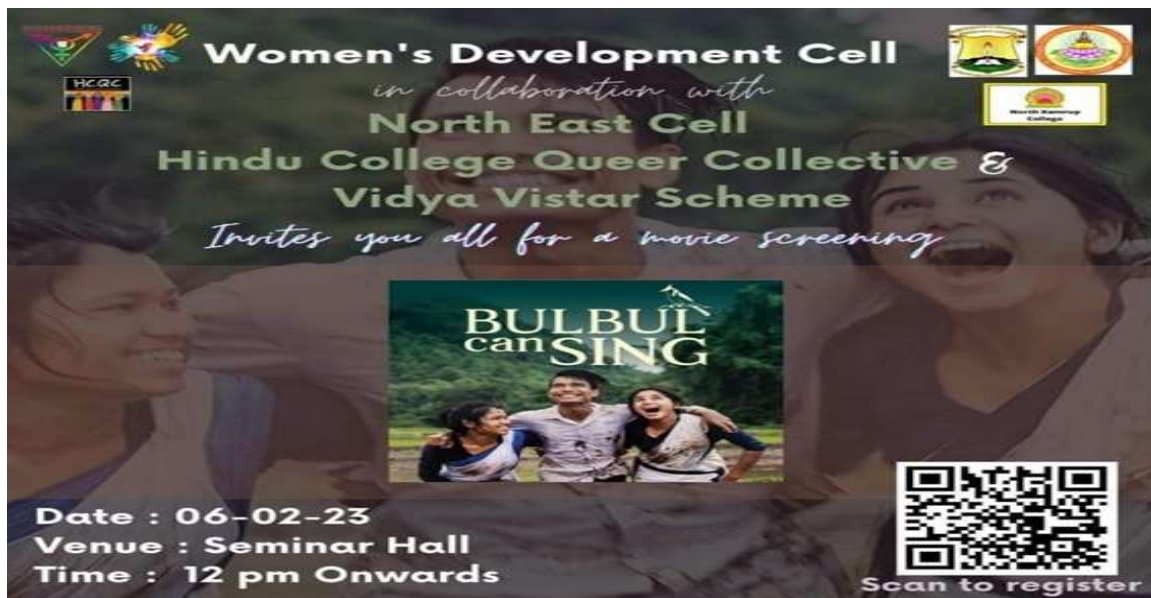


Awareness programme
