

- **(C) Open and Distance Learning System:** The college has been offering Post Graduate courses (in distance mode) since 2016. Through its Study Centre of 'Institute of Distance and Open Learning' (IDOL) under Gauhati University. Besides various diploma courses, the Centre offers Post Graduate and P.G. Diploma courses in Assamese, English, Political Science, History, Education, Philosophy and Bodo. Contact classes are held at regular interval and examinations of all the above courses are held at North Kamrup College as per the rules and regulations of IDOL.
- (D) P.G. Diploma / Certificate Courses: The college also offers P.G. Diploma / Certificate courses in i) CCA ii) PGDCA iii) B.A. (Gen.)
- **(E)** The college offers the following curriculum enrichment courses for a limited number of Degree first and second semester students. No extra fees have to be borne by the students for these courses. The students of degree classes may pursue any one of the courses.

Admission Procedure:


- 1. Candidates willing to admit themselves in the college have to apply in the prescribed form which can be downloaded from college website. Admission forms and Prospectus can be downloaded free of cost from our official website. Admission notice will be served at the notice board and in college website. Students are to be admitted both in merit and quota basis. Regarding admission, pressure from outside and from any corner is strictly prohibited.
- 2. There are reservations of seats for SC/ST/OBC/ MOBC as per govt. rules. A few seats are also reserved for students having proficiency in sports, culture and NCC. At the time of admission the candidates have to submit their original certificates and mark sheets for verification and they must be present physically with their guardians.
