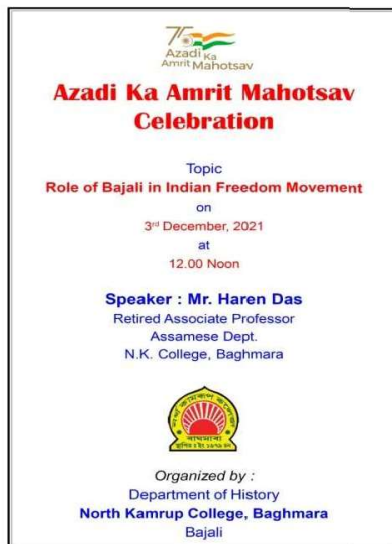
4. Name of the Programme: Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav celebration.
